



**99.3 County FM to Kickoff Fifth Anniversary Celebrations with Radiothon April 25 to 28,
Mark Campbell Named Radiothon Honourary Chair**

99.3 County FM, Prince Edward County's member-owned, volunteer operated, not-for-profit community radio station, today announced that long time volunteer and on-air personality Mark Campbell will be this year's Honourary Chair for the station's Radiothon, scheduled for April 25 to 28.

The Radiothon will raise funds to finish off the startup loan that helped put the station on the air in October, 2014.

Over the four days of Radiothon weekend, County FM listeners will be treated to live on-air performances by more than forty local musical acts. Listeners will also be able to visit the station to see the musicians perform live in the studio. Radiothon weekend will mark the opening of fifth anniversary celebrations for County FM, which will continue through the Spring and Summer, culminating with County FM's fifth anniversary on the air on October 14.

Honourary Chair Mark Campbell stated, "For the past five years, my best Friday afternoons have been when I go to County FM for my shift on the air, play music that listeners love, and connect with the community. It's great to see the fifth anniversary coming together and I'm happy to play a part."

Station General Manager Craig Mills added, "As the new General Manager at County FM, I'm deeply impressed by the legacy of support that the community has built around the station, and how the station has become an essential service. In this fifth anniversary year, it's vital that we raise enough money to pay off the last of the startup loan, so that we can focus all resources on providing the radio service that County residents need and have come to expect."
