- The following is a list of contest rules for the 10th Anniversary Fall Auction hosted by the Prince Edward County Radio Corporation, known as 99.3 County FM.
- The auction is open to all residents of Ontario, who are the age of majority (18 or older). Bidding takes place through the 99.3 County FM website which takes you to our 32 Auctions page.
- On-line preview begins Friday Oct 12th 6am EDT. Bidding opens Saturday Oct 12th at 6am EDT. Bidding closes Sunday, October 20th at 6pm EDT.
- Once you go through our website, to our 32 Auctions page, you will need to create an account to place a bid. The sign-up process is quick—just a name, valid email address (which is verified), and optionally a phone number.
- There are very good FAQs on the 32 Auctions site to answer all of your questions.
- When live event bidding ends the winning bidder will be notified by email.
- In the event that the winner is unable to pick up the item, or forfeits their item, the second highest bidder is contacted.
- 99.3 County FM will put the winner and donor in contact to arrange for fulfillment of the prize.
- Descriptions of items are in as much detail as possible. Details were provided by donors, 99.3 County FM is not responsible for verifying accuracy of said details.
- Many of our items are unique lifestyle and adventure items. The radio station and donors are acting in good faith to deliver a positive experience. If there are any significant issues with receipt of an item, 99.3 County FM will review the matter with the winning bidder to resolve any misunderstandings.
- Payments are made to the 99.3 County FM and are accepted via e-transfer, VISA, cash, debit, or cheque.
